

## Indicative

### Present

<b>I</b>	flunk
<b>you</b>	flunk
<b>he/she/it</b>	flunks
<b>we</b>	flunk
<b>you</b>	flunk
<b>they</b>	flunk

### Simple past

<b>I</b>	flunked
<b>you</b>	flunked
<b>he/she/it</b>	flunked
<b>we</b>	flunked
<b>you</b>	flunked
<b>they</b>	flunked

### Present perfect

<b>I</b>	have flunked
<b>you</b>	have flunked
<b>he/she/it</b>	has flunked
<b>we</b>	have flunked
<b>you</b>	have flunked
<b>they</b>	have flunked

### Past perfect

<b>I</b>	had flunked
<b>you</b>	had flunked
<b>he/she/it</b>	had flunked
<b>we</b>	had flunked
<b>you</b>	had flunked
<b>they</b>	had flunked

### Future

<b>I</b>	will flunk
<b>you</b>	will flunk
<b>he/she/it</b>	will flunk
<b>we</b>	will flunk
<b>you</b>	will flunk
<b>they</b>	will flunk

### Future perfect

<b>I</b>	will have flunked
<b>you</b>	will have flunked
<b>he/she/it</b>	will have flunked
<b>we</b>	will have flunked
<b>you</b>	will have flunked
<b>they</b>	will have flunked

## Conditional

### Present continuous

<b>I</b>	am flunking
<b>you</b>	are flunking
<b>he/she/it</b>	is flunking
<b>we</b>	are flunking
<b>you</b>	are flunking
<b>they</b>	are flunking

### Past continuous

<b>I</b>	was flunking
<b>you</b>	were flunking
<b>he/she/it</b>	was flunking
<b>we</b>	were flunking
<b>you</b>	were flunking
<b>they</b>	were flunking

### Present perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	have been flunking
<b>you</b>	have been flunking
<b>he/she/it</b>	has been flunking
<b>we</b>	have been flunking
<b>you</b>	have been flunking
<b>they</b>	have been flunking

### Past perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	had been flunking
<b>you</b>	had been flunking
<b>he/she/it</b>	had been flunking
<b>we</b>	had been flunking
<b>you</b>	had been flunking
<b>they</b>	had been flunking

### Future continuous

<b>I</b>	will be flunking
<b>you</b>	will be flunking
<b>he/she/it</b>	will be flunking
<b>we</b>	will be flunking
<b>you</b>	will be flunking
<b>they</b>	will be flunking

### Future perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	will have been flunking
<b>you</b>	will have been flunking
<b>he/she/it</b>	will have been flunking
<b>we</b>	will have been flunking
<b>you</b>	will have been flunking
<b>they</b>	will have been flunking

### Conditional present

<b>I</b>	would flunk
<b>you</b>	would flunk
<b>he/she/it</b>	would flunk
<b>we</b>	would flunk

<b>I</b>	would have flunked
<b>you</b>	would have flunked
<b>he/she/it</b>	would have flunked

## Subjunctive

### Present subjunctive

<b>I</b>	flunk
<b>you</b>	flunk
<b>he/she/it</b>	flunk
<b>we</b>	flunk
<b>you</b>	flunk
<b>they</b>	flunk

### Past perfect subjunctive

<b>I</b>	had flunked
<b>you</b>	had flunked
<b>he/she/it</b>	had flunked
<b>we</b>	had flunked
<b>you</b>	had flunked
<b>they</b>	had flunked

## Imperative

### Imperative

<b>you</b>	flunk
<b>we</b>	Let's flunk
<b>you</b>	flunk

### Present participle

### Conditional present progressive

<b>I</b>	would be flunking
<b>you</b>	would be flunking
<b>he/she/it</b>	would be flunking
<b>we</b>	would be flunking
<b>you</b>	would be flunking
<b>they</b>	would be flunking

### Conditional perfect progressive

<b>I</b>	would have been flunking
<b>you</b>	would have been flunking
<b>he/she/it</b>	would have been flunking
<b>we</b>	would have been flunking
<b>you</b>	would have been flunking
<b>they</b>	would have been flunking

### Past subjunctive

<b>I</b>	flunked
<b>you</b>	flunked
<b>he/she/it</b>	flunked
